## **EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 12, 2020**

Unless otherwise specified in a special award condition of the cooperative agreement, or as modified below, the <u>Cooperative Agreement Financial & Administrative Terms and Conditions</u> (CA-FATC) dated November 12, 2020 are applicable to this cooperative agreement or cooperative support agreement. When the Modifications and Supplemental Financial & Administrative Terms and Conditions for Major Multi-User Research Facility Projects and Federally Funded Research and Development Centers or an award notice reference a particular section of the <u>Major Facilities Guide</u>, then that section becomes part of the award requirements through incorporation by reference.

## **Summary of Changes**

- **Overall Document.** Article numbering has been updated to ensure consistency with the CA-FATC dated November 12, 2020.
- Federally-owned Property, Article 63. The submission of annual inventory reports, final inventory reports, disposition requests, prior approvals of transfers and disposal of Federally-owned property has been changed from the "NSF Property Administrator email address nsfproperty@nsf.gov" to the required submission using the NSF's Central Property Inventory Repository (CPIR) system. The requirement to submit annual inventory reports has been changed from "shall" to "must" and the requirement on using the Office of Management and Budget's, preapproved Post Award Reporting forms on the Grant.gov website, has been changed from "must" to "may".
- Recipient-titled Property, Article 64. The submission of final inventory reports, and Ad-Hoc requests of Federally-owned property has been changed from the "NSF Property Administrator email address nsfproperty@nsf.gov" to the required submission using the NSF's Central Property Inventory Repository (CPIR) system. The requirement to submit final inventory reports has been changed from "will" to "must".
